

General Guidelines for candidates

- Candidates/accompanying persons must maintain social distancing at every point and avoid crowding.
- Candidates are not allowed to exchange or loan articles inside the examination room.
- They should use safe mode of transportation for coming to the examination center and returning home.
- Candidates should dispose used tissue/face mask, if any, into closed bins immediately after use. They should observe the Green Protocol as well.
- Candidates belonging to symptomatic, quarantine/containment zone/hotspot category, should report sufficiently early on the examination day and inform the matter to the superintendent of their concerned examination centre. Such candidates shall be accommodated in a separate room arranged for the purpose.

Guidelines for COVID-19 positive candidates

1. COVID-19 positive candidates shall strictly follow the guidelines issued by the authorities concerned in this regard.
2. They should intimate the matter to the Recruitment & Examination Cell, High Court (Phone 04842562235, email: recruitment.hckerala@nic.in) at least two days before the examination. They should email the copies of relevant documents (COVID positive certificate and consent certificate from the Dept. of Health to travel and write the test) along with their consent (that they are willing to write the examination in accordance with the COVID protocol and other guidelines) to the email ID 'recruitment.hckerala@nic.in' and should produce the same as and when called for.
3. Separate arrangements will be made for COVID positive candidates to write the examination. They need not wear PPE kits. They should follow all other precautionary steps as mandated by the Government from time to time.
4. Such candidates should avoid all types of contact with any person inside or outside of the examination center.

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
