

India backs UN resolution against Israel for not leaving Syrian Golan

Context

- India has voted in favour of a draft resolution in the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) that expressed deep concern over Israel not withdrawing from the Syrian Golan.
- The Syrian Golan is a region in southwest Syria that was occupied by Israeli forces on June 5, 1967.
- The resolution also stressed the illegality of the Israeli settlement construction in the Golan.

Muslim student strength in higher education fell by 1.79 lakh in 2020-21

Context

Report based on analysis of UDISE+ and AISHE data shows:

- Muslim student enrolment in higher education (18-23 age group) dropped over 8.5% in 2020-21.
- This Reflects a significant decline in educational participation among Muslim youth.

Key points

- While 21 lakh Muslim students enrolled for higher education in 2019-20, the number fell to 19.21 lakh in 2020-21.
- The enrolment percentage of Muslim students in Classes 11 and 12 is lower than

Union govt receives 26 proposals to develop new cities	 Context: The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has received 26 proposals from 21 states, including Kerala, to develop new cities in view of urban expansion It was said that the 15th Finance Commission has allocated Rs 8,000 crore for the performance-based challenge fund for the incubation of new cities. Proposals received from Kerala are: Aerocity, Kannur OAGC Neopolis - The New City, Pallipuram Ernakulam Other proposals received are from cities such as: Ayodhya (UP) Jagiroad (Assam) New MOPA Ayush City, Pernem (Goa) GIFT city expansion (Gujarat) Pakyong (Sikkim), Thirumazhisai (Tamil Nadu) etc,.
Forest department freezes further proceedings on Chinnakanal reserve	Ontext: The forest department has decided to freeze further proceedings on the declaration of 364.89 hectares of land at Chinnakanal in Idukki as forest reserve, considering the protest launched by residents. It was clarified that no human settlement will be affected as only the forest land leased out to Hindustan Newsprint Ltd (HNL) for raising captive plantations will be converted into reserve forest.
No plans to relax net borrowing ceiling for states	The Union government informed that it has no plans to relax the existing terms on net borrowing ceiling for state governments, including Kerala
