PM	to	unveil	new	crop	varieties

#### Context:

 PM Modi is set to unveil a range of innovative crop varieties developed by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research's Central Plantation Crops Research Institute (ICAR-CPCRI), Kasaragod.

## **Key points:**

- This significant development is expected to bolster India's agricultural sector.
- PM is set to unveil **109 new crop** varieties.
- Among these, two coconut varieties Kalpa Suvarna and Kalpa Shatabdi - and two cocoa varieties - VTL CH1 and VTL CH2 - are particularly noteworthy.
- The new varieties are anticipated to offer increased yield, resistance to diseases and pests, and better adaptability to changing climatic conditions.

#### ICAR:

- ICAR stands for the **Indian Council of Agricultural Research**.
- It's an autonomous body under the Department of Agricultural Research and Education (DARE), Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India.

#### **Key Roles:**

- Agricultural Research: Conducts research to improve crop yields, develop new crop varieties, enhance livestock productivity, and address agricultural challenges.
- Education: Offers education and training in agriculture and allied sciences through its network of agricultural universities and institutes.
- **Extension:** Transfers agricultural technologies and best practices to farmers for increased productivity and sustainable agriculture.
- Policy Formulation: Provides scientific advice to the government on agricultural policies and programs.

- Built by the British, it has been a source of
