Clade 1b monkeypox	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>Kerala will issue Mpox prevention guidelines following a man testing positive for the rapidly spreading Clade 1b strain.</li> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>Monkeypox spreads primarily through close contact with an infected person's skin lesions, bodily fluids, or respiratory droplets.</li> <li>The Clade 1b monkeypox virus spreads through close physical contact. It is virulent in nature.</li> <li>Clade 1b strain of the virus is more infectious than Clade 2 and it is currently behind the global outbreak.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
'She-Toilet' project	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>Kerala's 'She Toilet' initiative has crumbled, failing to meet its objectives and provide the intended benefits to women in the region.</li> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>It was launched as a model initiative to provide safe, hygienic and accessible public restrooms for women.</li> <li>The plan was to establish women-friendly, technology-driven She Toilets equipped with various features such as coin-operated sanitary napkin vending machines, incinerators for disposing of used napkins, electronic display boards on the doors, security enhancements, FM radio, and SMS alerts.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ)	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>The Ministry of Forests, Environment and Climate Change on Monday approved the draft Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) Management Plan submitted by Kerala based on the 2019 Coastal Zone Regulation notification.</li> <li>Key Points:</li> <li>The Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) is a regulatory framework that aims to protect the coastal environment, preserve natural beauty, and manage coastal development.</li> <li>The CRZ Notification 2011, issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, categorizes coastal areas into five zones.</li> <li>CRZ-I: Ecologically sensitive areas</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>CRZ-II: Developed areas up to or near the shoreline</li> <li>CRZ-III: Rural areas and relatively undisturbed land areas</li> <li>CRZ-IV: Water areas up to 12 nautical miles from the territorial waters and tide-influenced water bodies</li> <li>CRZ-V: Areas that require special consideration for protecting the coastal environment.</li> </ul>
Peechi-Vazhani Wildlife Sanctuary	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>A female elephant was discovered dead near a tribal colony close to the Peechi Wildlife Sanctuary.</li> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>Peechi-Vazhani Wildlife Sanctuary is a wildlife sanctuary headquartered in Peechi, Thrissur District of Kerala, India.</li> <li>The sanctuary was established in 1958 consisting of Palappilli-Nelliyampathi forests including the area of Chimmony Wildlife sanctuary and is the second oldest sanctuary in Kerala.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Mechanical thrombectomy	<ul> <li>Why in news?</li> <li>For the first time, a mechanical thrombectomy procedure for stroke patients was conducted at a government hospital in Kerala.</li> <li>Key Points: <ul> <li>Mechanical thrombectomy is a minimally invasive procedure that removes blood clots from arteries to restore blood flow.</li> <li>It's often used to treat ischemic strokes, but can also be used for other conditions like pulmonary embolism and acute myocardial infarction.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
