	About: • India is home to 9 species of Vulture namely the Oriental white-backed, Long-billed, Slender-billed, Himalayan, Red-headed, Egyptian, Bearded, Cinereous, and the Eurasian Griffon.
	<ul> <li>IUCN Status:</li> <li>The species has been classified as critically endangered in the IUCN</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>About:</li> <li>Mpox, formerly known as monkeypox, is a viral illness caused by the monkeypox virus.</li> <li>It is a rare disease similar to smallpox and can spread through close contact with an infected person or animal.</li> </ul>
	Symptoms: • Fever • Headache • Muscle aches • Swollen lymph nodes • Fatigue • Rash that can appear on the face, hands, feet, or genitals
	<ul> <li>Transmission:</li> <li>Close contact with an infected person's rash or bodily fluids</li> <li>Contact with contaminated materials or objects</li> <li>Contact with infected animals.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Vaccine:</li> <li>The primary vaccine used for mpox prevention is JYNNEOS, which is a two-dose vaccine.</li> <li>The vaccine provides significant protection against mpox, reducing the risk of severe illness and death</li> </ul>
