KRDCL aims to install Kavach for railways	 Context: KRDCL (Kerala Rail Development Corporation Ltd) is a joint venture between the Government of Kerala and the Ministry of Railways. It is planning to bid for more railways projects this time to install a train collision avoidance system called Kavach. About: KAVACH, which stands for "Kavach Automatic Train Protection System," is an indigenously developed automatic train protection (ATP) system by Indian Railways through Research Designs & Standards Organisation (RDSO). It is a state-of-the-art electronic system with Safety Integrity Level-4 (SIL-4) standards, which is the highest level of safety for safety-related systems. KAVACH is designed to prevent train accidents caused by human error, such as signal passing at danger (SPAD) and overspeeding. It uses a combination of onboard and trackside equipment to monitor the train's position and speed, and to automatically apply the brakes if necessary.
Child sexual abuse cases in state rise fourfold in 10 yrs	 The trackside equipment includes balises (electronic tags) and radio antennas. Context: The cases of child sexual abuse, encompassing all forms of assault, registered under Pocso Act sections in the state, show nearly a fourfold increase in the last 10 years. The annual report of the Kerala State Commission for Protection of Child Rights for 2023-24 shows children, both boys and girls, continue to face sexual abuse at the hands of acquaintances, relatives, family members, teachers, lovers, neighbours, and unknown persons. Key Points: According to the report, 1,002 Pocso cases were registered in Kerala in 2013, and the number skyrocketed to 4,663 in 2023, with a steady rise every year. Experts say the rise in cases registered is due to increased public awareness about the need to report the sexual abuse of

	 children to the police. The report also indicates that the highest number of cases were registered in Thiruvananthapuram (593), Ernakulam (516) and Malappuram (514) in 2023.
