24-hour online court opens in Kollam district	 Context: Kerala's Kollam district has made history by launching India's first 24-hour online court. This occurs due to a deficiency in specific clotting factors, essential proteins in the blood that help form clots. Types of Haemophilia: Hemophilia A: The most common type, caused by a deficiency in clotting factor VIII. Hemophilia B: Less common, caused by a deficiency in clotting factor IX
