QS (Quacquarelli Symonds) World University Rankings	 Context: In the recently published QS (Quacquarelli Symonds) World University Rankings on Sustainability, Cochin University of Science and Technology (Cusat) was named among the top 1,000 universities. Key Points: Cusat is placed in the 971-980 band globally, ranking 299th in Asia, 53rd in South India, 38th in India, and first in Kerala. Cusat also achieved significant rankings in several sub-categories, securing the 609th position globally in the environmental impact category and 576th in governance. Of the 1,744 institutions evaluated in the rankings, University of Kerala was placed in the 1,181-1,200 band.

Citations per Faculty: Measures the research impact of a university's faculty. International Faculty Ratio: Assesses the proportion of international faculty members. International Student Ratio: Measures the proportion of international students.
