Kerala Forest Amendment Bill 2024	 Context: Farmers in Kerala have expressed concerns regarding the recently proposed Kerala Forest Amendment Bill, claiming it grants excessive powers to forest officers. About: The Kerala Forest Amendment Bill, 2024, was notified by the Government of Kerala on November 1, 2024. This bill proposes several amendments to the Kerala Forest Act, 1961, with the aim of strengthening forest protection and management.
	 Key Provisions of the Bill: Enhanced Powers for Forest Officials: As per the Wildlife Protection Act, only a divisional forest officer or an assistant conservator of forests has the power to issue a warrant. But the new bill empowers a beat forest officer to conduct a search in a house and to arrest a person without a warrant. Besides, a forest watcher, who is only a temporary staffer, has been given the power to stop and search vehicles. Increased Penalties: The bill proposes a fivefold hike in penalties for forest offenses. Stricter Regulations on Forest Fringe Areas: The bill aims to regulate activities in forest fringe areas to prevent encroachment and deforestation. Strengthened Provisions for Forest Conservation: The bill introduces several measures to enhance forest conservation efforts, such as stricter

	 The minute-long film is written and directed by Mumbai-based cinematographer K O Akhil, who has captured the very beginning of Kerala's cinematic heritage, the historic notice announcement of 'Vigathakumaran', the first film in Malayalam that was directed by J C Daniel. Swapnaayanam also pays tribute to P K Rosy, the heroine of Vigathakumaran. The film ends with a visual of Rosy, portrayed by Abhirami Bose, enjoying a movie in a modern theatre.

Digital University Kerala	 Context: The Digital University Kerala (DUK) has won its first Indian patent for the invention of a gravity driven apparatus for reinfusing the blood of patients during surgeries.
	 Key Points: The device, developed by a team of researchers led by Dr Joseph Tharion, senior research scientist at DUK, could prove to be path-breaking for patients who rupture the fallopian tube in ectopic pregnancies. In such cases, delay in removing the blood collected in the abdominal cavity could even endanger the life of patients. Globally, the mortality rate due to ectopic pregnancy is 3.5%, while in India it is 1.5-2%. In tribal hamlets, northeastern states, conflict zones, and continents like Africa, fatality rates are very high. This achievement is expected to pave the way for further innovations in the field of medical devices and healthcare solutions in India.
