	 The Eknath Shinde government in Maharashtra is launching a "Chief Minister Women Empowerment Campaign" ahead of upcoming elections.
	 Key Points: The campaign aims to provide government scheme benefits to at least one lakh women in each district of the state. The campaign will be coordinated by the Chief Minister's
	 secretariat, with a committee chaired by Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, including various stakeholders. Monthly meetings will be held, and the State Women and Child Development Minister will review the campaign's progress. An IAS officer will serve as the state coordination nodal
	• An IAS officer will serve as the state coordination hodal officer, and District Collectors will act as district coordinators for the campaign.
New Healthcare Vision 2035 after weeks of tragedy	 In news: Tragedy in Nanded Hospital: 38 patients died within 72 hours due to staff shortage and lack of medical supplies.
	 Key Points: Following public outcry, the state government launched a program called Vision 2035 to address healthcare issues. The Chief Minister instructed the public health department to create a plan to establish government hospitals in 25 districts and fill staff vacancies. The state aims to align existing district hospitals with medical colleges and build new state-of-the-art hospitals to improve healthcare infrastructure. 18000 crore worth health projects including setting up and upgrading existing ones.

Key Points: As part of this scheme Rs.6000(paid in instalments) will be transferred to farmer accounts in addition to the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Yojana which is a centrally sponsered scheme.

Key Points: Families with an annual income up to ₹1 lakh are eligible for this scheme, which provides financial assistance of ₹1,01,000 in phases until the girl reaches the age of 18. Under the scheme: families having yellow and orange ration cards will get ₹5,000 at the time of birth, ₹6,000 when she enters Class 1, ₹7,000 after entering Class 6, ₹8,000 after entering Class 11 and ₹75,000 after completing 18 years of age. Max- 2 girls in a family will be benefitted who are born after April 1 2023.
Majhi Kanya Bhagya Scheme	• In this scheme, the Government used to keep a fixed deposit of ₹25,000 for one time , and the maturity amount was given to the girl at the age of 18.
