World AIDS Day



Context:

- World AIDS Day is observed annually on December 1st.
- It is a global health awareness day dedicated to raising awareness of the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS), as well as honoring those who have lost their lives to the disease.
- It was initiated in 1988 by WHO
- World Health Organization (WHO), alongside communities and partners, will mark World AIDS Day 2023, under the theme "Let communities lead".

33% spike in sexually transmitted infections in 2022-2023

Context:

- The state of Maharashtra has seen a concerning 33% surge in sexually transmitted infections (STIs) in 2022-23, with a total of 1 lakh cases diagnosed.
- Data shows that 96% of new infections result from unsafe sex
- Maharashtra State Aids Control Society (MSACS) warns that individuals with STIs have a higher risk of acquiring and transmitting HIV.
- The **national AIDS program** is also facing shortages of condoms, testing kits, and medicines.

Schools turn to U-DISE Plus



Context:

- To bring uniformity in the education policy of the country, the Union Ministry of Education collects all the school information through the UNIFIED DISTRICT INFORMATION SYSTEM FOR EDUCATION PLUS (UDISE+)' website.
- But more than 38 thousand schools in the state have turned their backs to fill information online.
- SAKAL Exclusive Schools turn to UDISE Plus Including more than 38 thousand schools in state Nashik.

About UDISE+

 The Department of School Education and Literacy introduced UDISE+ in 2018-19, an online data collection system for schools.

- **Objective:** UDISE+ addresses challenges associated with manual paper-based data entry, a practice in place since 2012-13, streamlining the data collection process.
- **Enhancements:** Significant improvements in data capture, mapping, and verification processes distinguish UDISE+, enhancing overall efficiency.

UDISE+ 2021-22 Highlights:

- **Digital Library Data:** For the first time, UDISE+ 2021-22 incorporates information on digital libraries.
- Peer Learning: The system now includes data on peer learning initiatives in schools.
- **Hard Spot Identification:** Identifying and documenting hard spots is a new feature in the latest UDISE+ version.
- School Library Books: Data collection now extends to the number of books available in each school library.

Jalyukta Shivar 2.0



Context:

- The State govt said that Jalyukta Shivar will be implemented in mission mode by making Jalyukta Shivar a public movement.
- In order to speed up the second phase of Jalyukta Shivar in the state, a MoU was signed by the state government with the Person Vikas Kendra-Art of Living organization.

About:

- Jalyukta Shivar 2.0 is a comprehensive water conservation scheme launched by the Government of Maharashtra in 2020.
- It is the second phase of the Jalyukta Shivar scheme, which was initiated in 2015.
- The **aim** of the scheme is to make **Maharashtra drought-free** by conserving water and enhancing its availability for agriculture and other purposes.

Skyway to connect Hinjewadi Metro stn to IT hub's doorstep

- The Pune Metropolitan Region Development Authority (PMRDA) has proposed a skyway to connect the Hinjewadi Metro station to various companies in the IT hub for lastmile connectivity.
- PMRDA said that the authority has tied up with a private company to construct the skyway's pilot test track of 2.5km
