Vishwashanti Buddha Vihar



Context:

 President Droupadi Murmu inaugurated the Vishwashanti Buddha Vihar in Udgir, Latur district of Maharashtra.

About the Buddha Statue:

- A grand statue of Lord Buddha, weighing 520 kilograms and standing 10.5 feet tall, was installed at the Buddha Vihar.
- The Buddha Vihar, which spans **1.15 hectares**, has a seating capacity for 1,200 people.
- Its entry gate is inspired by the design of the famous Sanchi Stupa gate located in Madhya Pradesh.
- Officials highlighted that this Buddha Vihar is modeled after a similar structure in Kalaburagi, Karnataka.

Call for Anti-Rape Bill in Maharashtra

Context:

 Sharad Pawar, the president of NCP (SP), has proposed replicating a bill passed by the West Bengal Assembly in Maharashtra, which seeks capital punishment for rape convicts.

About:

 West Bengal passed the Aparajita Woman and Child Bill (2024), advocating capital punishment for rape convicts whose actions lead to the victim's death or vegetative state.

Key features include:

- Death Penalty: Convicted rapists who result in the death or permanent vegetative state of the victim could face the death penalty.
- **Life Imprisonment**: For other rape and gang rape cases, life imprisonment without parole is proposed.
- **Repeat Offenders:** Repeat offenders could also face life imprisonment or the death penalty.
- **Special Task Force**: A district-level task force will be established to investigate rape and sexual offenses.

	 Speedy Investigations: Investigations must be completed within 21 days, with possible extensions. Specialized Courts: 52 special courts will be set up to handle rape and sexual offense cases efficiently. Privacy Protections: Penalties are introduced for unauthorized printing or publishing of court proceedings related to rape cases. Victim-Centered Approach: The bill aims to minimize trauma for victims and their families through swift justice and sensitive handling of cases. Safety Measures: The bill includes provisions for increased CCTV surveillance and security for women, especially those working night shifts.
Tungareshwar Wildlife sanctuary	The State Board of Wildlife (SBWL) has approved a proposal to regularise an ashram situated on forest land within the Tungareshwar Wildlife Sanctuary. Despite earlier recommendations for its removal, the ashram, owned by Shri Balayogi Sadanand Maharaj Ashram Trust, is now on track for regularisation.
	 About: Tungareshwar wildlife sanctuary also known as Tungareshwar National Park is located on a plateau east of Vasai and Virar in Palghar district, north of Mumbai in the Indian state Maharashtra. The sanctuary is over 85 km2 and forms a corridor between Sanjay Gandhi National Park and Tansa Wildlife Sanctuary. Tungareshwar was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 2003.
