- 2. All the shortlisted candidates should report to the Dept. of Chem. Engg. (Block II, Room 278) at **08:30 AM** on **16.05.2019** (**THURSDAY**). Candidates should make their travel plan such that they might have to stay till late evening.
- 3. No TA is admissible to the candidates appearing for test/interview for admission to M.Tech./ M.S.(Research) programmes.
- 4. Fee once paid for a particular programme will not be adjusted/ transferred if the student gets selected subsequently and joins in another programme. He/She will have to pay the fee for the new programme he/she joins and apply for refund of fee earlier paid for a programme he/she wishes to withdraw. The refund of fee will be made as per rules of the Institute.
- 5. Hostel accommodation for candidates coming for interviews is arranged at ZANSKAR hostel (caretaker number: 011 2659 7068) for male candidates and at HIMADRI hostel (caretaker number: 011 2659 7135) for the female candidates. The hostel accommodation will be provided on a sharing basis on payment of Rs. 400 per day (lodging & boarding).
