Candidates, who qualified in the Trade Test will be called for appearing in the Competitive Written Examination tentatively scheduled to be held on 17.05.2026 (Sunday) at CSIR-IICT, Hyderabad. The exact date, time and venue of the Trade Test & Competitive Written Examination will be notified in due course by displaying in CSIR-IICT website.

English Language	25	75 (three marks for every correct answer)	One negative mark for every wrong answer

Paper-III (Time Allotted – 1 Hour)

Subject	No. of Question	Maximum Marks	Negative Marks
Concerned Subject	50	150 (three marks for every correct answer)	One negative mark for every wrong answer

There will be three papers (Paper-I, Paper-II, Paper-III). Paper-II & Paper-III will be evaluated only for those candidates who secure the minimum threshold marks (to be determined by the Selection Committee) in the Paper-I. The Final merit list will be prepared only on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in Paper-II & III.

The candidature of the candidate for Competitive Written Examination is provisional and is subject to verification of all essential requirements/ documents. At any stage of the recruitment process, if it is found that Applicant has furnished wrong information or does not meet the essential qualification/ criteria or the candidate indulges in any canvassing in any manner in support of his/ her candidature, such candidate's candidature will be cancelled without any further notice.

In this regard, the eligible candidates are required to download the admit card to appear for the Trade Test & Competitive Written Examination from their Emails prior to one week before the exam, which will be notified in due course. In any circumstances request from candidates for change of date of examination will not be entertained.

No TA/DA will be provided to the candidates for attending the Trade Test or the Competitive Written Examination. Candidates who are required to attend both the Trade Test and the Written Examination are advised to make their own arrangements for stay, as the Institute will not provide any kind of accommodation.
