**Sub: Approved Vacancies of JE-DMS-CMA (pay level-6) for notification in 2026**

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Assessment of vacancies of JE-DMS-CMA categories done by Zonal Railways/PUs in the Indent Management module of HRMS has been examined in Railway Board.

2. The competent authority (CRB & CEO) has approved to issue Centralized Employment Notification (CEN) for **4098** vacancies in **35** categories of Junior Engineers, Depot Material Superintendents (DMS) and Chemical and Metallurgical Assistants (CMA), all in pay level-6, for the year 2026 as given below:

3. The Railway/PU-wise distribution of vacancies is given in **Annexure – A**. Immediate action should be taken by the Zonal Railways and PUs for placing final indent (not exceeding vacancies approved by Railway Board) in OIRMS portal. While placing indent, Railways/Units should ensure prescribed reservation norms for SC/ST/OBC/EWS etc. (both backlog and current) and shortfall, if any, should be properly accounted for.
4. Nodal RRB will identify the categories with identical medical standards, PwBD attributes, educational and technical qualifications based on the post parameters and issue the CEN after clubbing the vacancies of these categories. There should be clear mention about the categories getting clubbed in the CEN so that the candidates are aware of the clubbing. The CEN will also include a provision specifically that final allotment of department and category to the empanelled candidates will be done by the concerned Railways and PUs based on the vacancies available and community wise distribution.

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5. Following timeline is fixed, in consultation with Chairperson/RRB/ Bengaluru, for placing the final indent in OIRMS.
