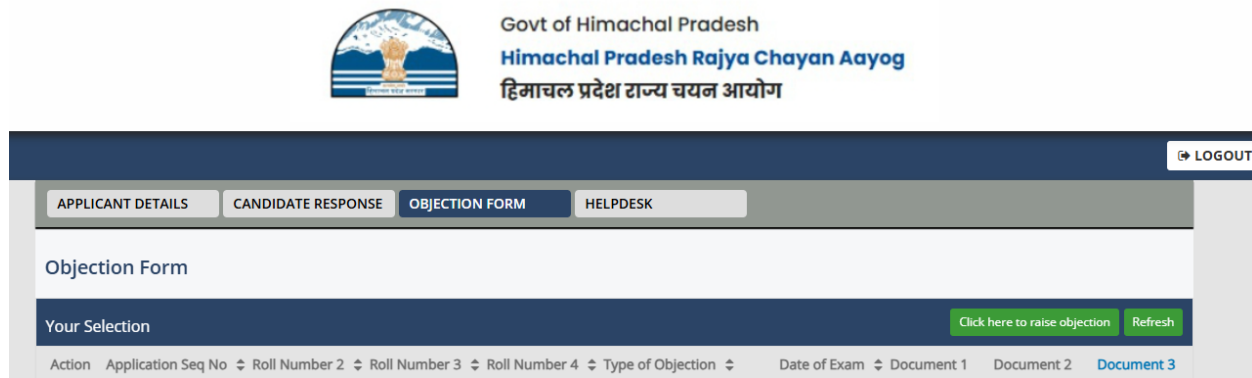

- 4) Click on "Click to refresh" button to see objections raised by you in "Your Selection" page. / " Your Selection "
- 5) Before raising objection, go through the question and options carefully.
- 6) Objections must be entered only in English. Ambiguous Objections may not be considered for evaluation.
- 7) Objections can be raised only against questions and their respective options.
- 8) In the remarks column, enter your reason for objection clearly. Objections with no valid explanation or reference will not be taken into account and will be discarded.
- 9) Before submission of Objection it is mandatory for candidate to upload supporting document(s).
- 10) Maximum 3 supporting documents can be uploaded for an objection or question. The supporting document should not be of more than 400kb size and should be in PDF/ JPG/ JPEG format.
- 11) Objections once submitted cannot be edited later.
- 12) Any objection raised by the candidate shall be charged at Rs.200 per question and must be supported by authentic source.
- 13) Once an objection is raised for any question, fees will not be refunded. If you want to raise new objection against same/different question, you have to pay again.
