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Online applications are invited for admission to Ph.D. Programme in the School of Science & Technology, Commerce & Management, Humanities & Social Sciences, Continuing Education and Education in regular mode for Session 2023.

Important Guidelines

Procedure for the Ph.D. Entrance Examination

Online admission form shall be filled on the vacant seats in the subjects declared. The admission shall be based on the criteria notified by the institution, keeping in view the guidelines/norms in this regard issued by the UGC and other statutory/regulatory bodies concerned, and taking into account the reservation policy of the Central/State Government from time to time.

Eligibility Criteria for admission

A candidate shall be eligible for admission and pre-registration course work for Ph. D. programme provided he/she has:

- 1. Candidates for admission to the Ph.D. programme shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC-7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.
- 2. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed)

and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

B Entrance Examination Fee & Mode of Payment

Candidates have to pay an amount of Rs 500/- (five hundred only) for Entrance examination fee through online mode (credit card/ net banking / e-mitra). Fee once deposited will not be refunded.

C Course Work

- 1. Selected Students will undergo common course work for 8 credits and subject based course work for 8 credits (in the department concerned on the basis of recommendation of Research Advisory Committee.
- 2. After six months the candidate(s) shall be examined through Continuous Assessment.
- **3.** 75% attendance of the student in the Pre-Ph.D. Course Work both in Module 1&2 and Module III will be compulsory.
- **4.** Successful candidate(s) then shall submit a synopsis and also make a presentation before the Research Board

E General Instructions for Ph.D. Entrance Test for those subjects wherein sufficient numbers of candidates did not appear or scholarships are not provided.

- (1) The Ph.D. Entrance examination will be held at **Kota** only.
- (2) Time allotted for Ph.D. Entrance examination: Total 02 Hrs.
- (3) Admit card to be downloaded from the University website: www.vmou.ac.in, available before the date of written Examination. Candidates should bring with them a valid original ID.
- (4) The question paper of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50 MCQs of Research methodology (Research, Language(Hindi/English), Computer applications & Logical reasoning) and 50 MCQs shall be subject specific.
- (5) Question paper will be bilingual (Hindi and English) except the language paper.
- (6) There will be **NO** Negative Marking in the written examination.

- (7) The aggregate qualifying marks in entrance examination for all candidates will be 50%.
- (8) In case of tie between successful candidates in any subject in the final merit, it will be resolved by comparing the P.G. marks. If the tie is not resolved then further the marks obtained by the candidates in U.G. will be compared to determine the final merit.
- (9) The University shall admit pre-determined number of students in the Ph. D.
- (10) In addition to the educational qualifications the applicant shall submit NoC as following:
 - a. Certificate issued by the employer to allow him/her to fulfill the residential requirement during course work (180 days leave for attending the class of course work) and contact days (as required by the university) with supervisor after completion of the course work as notified by University from time to time.
 - **b.** Permission of the employer in writing to the candidate, to pursue Ph.D programme along with his/her regular duties in the organization he/ she is employed.
 - **c.** Availability of all facilities for pursuing research at the candidate's parent organization / place of work, in the chosen field of research.
- (11) The Date of registration (Fee Deposition) shall be the Date of admission, but the letter of registration shall be issued after successful completion of Course Work.
- (12) All the information related to entrance schedule, entrance examination, result, interview, course work etc. shall be uploaded on University website. Candidates should frequently visit the website for updated information.

- Research Design: Concept and Importance in Research Features of a good research design

- Qualitative & Quantitative Research: Qualitative research Quantitative research Concept of measurement, causality, generalization, and replication. Merging the two approaches.
