Subject: Release of Admit Card for Graduate Aptitude Test - Biotechnology (GAT-B) 2025.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will conduct Graduate Aptitude Test – Biotechnology (GAT-B) 2025 on **20 April 2025** through the Computer Based Test (CBT) mode.

Admit Cards for the examination are hosted on the NTA website https://www.nta.ac.in/ or https://dbt2025.ntaonline.in/

Candidates can download their respective Admit Cards from website using their Application Form Number and Date of Birth.

Candidates are advised to note the following:

- The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidates, subject to the fulfilment of the eligibility conditions.
- Admit Card will not be sent by post.
- Candidate must not mutilate the Admit Card or change any entry made thereon.
- Issue of Admit Card, however, will not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which shall be further scrutinized at subsequent stages of the admission process.
- Candidates are advised to preserve a copy of their Admit Card and keep it in good condition for future reference.
