- 1. As per clause 7.3 of Notification No. F. No. NMC/MCI-23(I)/2021-MED., New Delhi, the 14th February, 2022 “In the case of Broad Specialty/ Super Specialty courses which were newly instituted, relaxation of qualification and experience for appointment as faculty during transition period was granted for ten years from the date of start of the course by erstwhile Medical Council of India”.

Again as per clause 7.4 of the aforesaid Notification “This relaxation of qualification and experience during transition period mentioned in clause 7.3, shall be extended for five more years from the date of notification of this Regulation to all the Broad and super specialty courses which were started after 01 January, 2009”.

Thus from 14th February, 2022, the 5 year relaxation may likely to end on 13th February, 2027 and as such the said relaxation is still available as on date.

2. Relaxation of qualification may be provided as per the relaxation indicated during the transition period in the said gazette notification **if suitable candidates are not found**.

3. The Teaching and Research Experience, as mentioned in Table 3B is essential requirement. The relaxation applies, only to the academic qualification as per NMC gazette.

E- Age:

As per NOTIFICATION No. HF/O/MA (MES)/906/ME/MISC-88-2021, dated, Kolkata, the 18th Nov, 2021: "West Bengal Medical Education Service (Recruitment to Teaching Posts) Rules, 2021",

Not more than 45(Forty-five) years on the 1st day of January of the year of Advertisement. Age relaxation may be given to such doctors who have served under this State Government, to an extent equivalent to the period of such service, subject to a maximum of 05(five) years:

Provided that age may also be relaxable for the candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes as per Government rules or orders for the time being in force.

Note:

(d) The West Bengal Health Recruitment Board (WBHRB) may require such further proof or particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries regarding eligibility.
