

STATUTES FOR APPOINTMENT AS ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN THE UNIVERSITIES OF BIHAR, 2025

Chapter-1

- 1.0 **Short title, extent and commencement-** These Statutes may be called " The statutes for appointment of Assistant Professor for the Universities of Bihar, 2025".
- 1.1 It shall be applicable to all the Universities governed under Bihar State Universities Act, 1976, Patna University Act, 1976 and any other University Act of the Bihar as decided by the State Government.
- 1.2 It shall come into force with effect from the date of issuance of the assent by the Chancellor.

Chapter-2

- 2.0 **Definitions-** In these Statutes, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,
- 2.1 "Chairman" means "Chairman of Bihar State University Service Commission".
- 2.2 "Commission" means "The Bihar State University Service Commission as established under section-3 of the Bihar State University Service Commission Act- 2017".
- 2.3 "Department" means "Higher Education Department, Government of Bihar"
- 2.4 "Member" means "Member of Bihar State University Service Commission"
- 2.5 'NET' National Eligibility Test for Assistant Professorship.
- 2.6 "SLET/SET" means "State-Level Eligibility Test conducted by the Bihar government or on its behalf for this purpose"
- 2.7 "State Government" means" The Government of Bihar".
- 2.8 "Statutes" means "The Statutes for appointment of Assistant Professors for the Universities of Bihar, 2025".
- 2.9 "Teacher" means an "Assistant Professor"
- 2.10 "UGC" means "University Grants Commission"
- 2.11 "University" means a university as defined under the "Bihar State Universities Act, 1976, Patna University Act, 1976 and any other University Act of the Bihar".

- 2.12 Vice Chancellor means "Vice Chancellor of the University".
2.13 "Written Exam" means written examination conducted by the Bihar State University Service Commission.

Chapter-3

3.0 Appointment of Teachers (Assistant Professors)

3.1 Objective

3.1.1 The objective is to ensure that the candidates possess optimum knowledge of the subject, teaching and research capabilities, the ability to motivate students, and proficiency in modern teaching tools and technology.

3.2 Procedure of appointment

3.2.0 The appointment shall be made through an open All India Advertisement.

3.2.1 The appointment of Assistant Professors shall be made on the recommendation of the Bihar State University Service Commission in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the University Grants Commission (UGC) and adopted / modified by the Government of Bihar.

3.2.2 The Competent Authority of the Universities on the basis of subject wise vacancies of teachers along with reservation roster shall send requisition to the Commission through the Higher Education Department. The Department shall consolidate the requisitions from the Universities and after due diligence forward it to the Commission.

3.3 The Department shall consolidate and prioritize subject requisitions based on urgency and requirement. The Commission shall accordingly undertake the selection process on a priority basis for the requisitioned subjects.

3.4 Essential qualifications

3.4.1 A Master's degree with 55% marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale, wherever the grading system is followed, in concerned / relevant / allied subjects from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. Relaxation of 5% for SC/ST/EBC (Non-creamy layer)/ BC (Non-creamy layer) candidates of the State, while Specially Abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental

illness;(e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf- blindness) with minimum disability percentage as prescribed by the competent authority for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for recruitment from any part of the country will be given relaxation of 5% marks at Master's Degree. But both benefits shall not be admissible to the same candidate.

3.4.2 Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC at National Level or state-level eligibility test (SLET/SET) conducted by the Bihar government or by the agency on its behalf for this purpose.

Provided that the candidates having a Ph.D. Degree in relevant discipline in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and as amendments from time to time, may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye- laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/State-Level Eligibility Test (SLET/SET) conducted by the Bihar government or on its behalf for this purpose subject to fulfillment of the following conditions.

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs/Concerned Faculty) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign University/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

3.4.3 In the context of disciplines like Music, Performing Arts, Visual Arts and other Traditional Art forms like sculpture etc and Drama/Natya, the eligibility of a traditional or professional artist will be judged according to the criteria for specific disciplines laid down in UGC Regulation on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teacher in Universities and colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 or as amended from time to time.

3.5 Age limit

The minimum age for appointment as an Assistant Professor shall be 23 years, and the maximum age shall not exceed 45 years as of August 1st of the year of advertisement. Age relaxation will be given as per State Government rules, whereas age relaxation for specially abled (as defined in clause 3.4.1) will be as per the Government of India rules.

3.6 Pay Scale

The Pay scale of Assistant Professors of the University shall be same as recommended by the University Grants Commission from time to time and adopted by Government of Bihar.

3.7 Interview Board

3.7.1 The Interview Board shall consist of a minimum of three subject experts not below the Rank of Professor, nominated by the Chairman of the Commission. The Chairman of the Interview Board shall be either the Chairman of the Commission or a Member of the Commission, as nominated by the Chairman of the Commission.

- 3.7.2 The procedure for conducting the interview shall be determined by the Commission, ensuring fairness and transparency and also to explore the qualifications as described in clause 3.1 objectives of these statutes.
- 3.8 **Scrutiny and Short listing of Candidate for interview:-** The short listing of candidates for the interview shall be conducted based on their performance in the written examination among all eligible candidates in the respective subject/ discipline. The scrutiny and short listing process shall be carried out in accordance with the criteria and provisions prescribed in **Annexure- I**.
- 3.9 **Eligibility of candidates with degree in Concerned / Relevant / Allied Subjects:** - The eligibility of candidates holding a Master's/PG degree in concerned/relevant/allied subjects shall be as prescribed in the statutes and be determined by the Commission. The equivalence of similar subjects offered under different nomenclature at the Master's level in various universities shall be decided by the Commission with the help of concerned Universities, ensuring uniformity and compliance with academic standard. The same shall be published in **Annexure-II** of these statutes. Commission can add, delete or modify the concerned/relevant/allied subjects before the advertisement for the post is floated using the same procedure as prescribed before.
- 3.10 **Number of candidates called for interview:** For each post, the number of candidate to be shortlisted for the interview shall be in the ratio of 1:3 from the concerned subject, strictly based on their merit in the written examination. However, if the number of eligible candidates for a particular post doesn't conform to the above ratio then all eligible candidates may be called for the interview without any further short listing. Also, if more than one candidate is having same marks at the end of the merit position as per the prescribed ratio, in that case all such candidates will be called for interview.
- 3.11 The syllabus of the written examination will be that of NET examination in the concerned subject/discipline. For those subjects/discipline where NET examinations are not conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, the syllabus shall be prepared and notified by

the commission seeking help from the syllabus committee at Bihar Lok Bhawan.

- 3.12 The written examination will be of descriptive type and the model question paper be prepared by the Commission describing the nature and number of questions to be asked and notified before the advertisement.
- 3.13 **Processing Fee:** The Commission shall determine the application processing fee, as deemed appropriate for inviting application.

Chapter-4

4.0. **Reservation**

- 4.1 The Reservation Policy of the State Government, as applicable on the date of advertisement, shall be strictly followed. The reservation shall be followed category-wise and subject-wise, in accordance with the roster prepared by the university administration or the State Government.

If a candidate belonging to a reserved category secure marks that qualify them for the selection under the general merit list, they shall be considered for selection under the unreserved category.


Chapter-5

5.0 **Selection Process**

- 5.1 The Commission shall conduct a written examination for all eligible candidates in the concerned subject, carrying a total of 160 marks with duration of 3 hours. The minimum qualifying percentage shall be 50% for all candidates, except for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), and Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates, for whom it shall be 45%. The written examination shall account for 80% of the total weightage in the overall selection process.
- 5.2 Only qualified and shortlisted candidates based on the written examination shall be called for the interview.

- 5.3 The interview shall carry 40 marks. Attendance and appearance in the interview is mandatory.
- 5.4 Merit List Preparation: - The final merit list shall be prepared on the basis of 80% weightage of written examination (full marks 160) and interview 20% weightage (Full marks-40)) i.e. total marks-200. (Annexure-1)
- 5.5 The Commission shall prepare a composite merit list for each subject, considering the number of vacancies and the reservation roster. Based on this composite merit list, a university-wise panel shall be formulated, duly taking into account the preferences of universities as specified by the candidates. The finalized university-wise panel shall be forwarded to the Department for further action.
- 5.6 In the event of total marks obtained from written examination and interview being the same, candidate having higher marks in written examination shall be placed higher in the final merit list. In the event of candidate having same marks in interview and written examination then candidate who is older in age according to the date of birth shall be placed higher in the final merit list and in the event of candidates having same date of birth, candidates whose name appears alphabetically first in Devnagiri Script shall be placed higher in the final merit list.
- 5.7 The procedure for interview shall be decided by the Commission. The merit list prepared by the Commission shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance of appointment letter.
- 5.8 Commission shall also prepare a composite merit list of written examination of such candidates who are not recommended for the posting in concerned subject after conducting interview. This list will be communicated to the Universities through Higher Education Department Universities may use this list for selection of Guest Faculties, if any.

6.0 Appointment

- 6.1 The Commission shall submit its recommendation of the selected candidates to the Higher Education Department. The Department shall forward the recommendation to the Vice-Chancellor of the

respective university for further necessary action and appointment.

6.2 The Vice-Chancellor shall, subject to the provisions of the Act, shall have the power to appoint teachers as per the recommendations of the Commission. Such appointments shall be made within the prescribed grade and pay scale and within the sanctioned strength of the university. Before finalizing the appointment, the University shall examine all relevant certificates and documents to ensure compliance with the prescribed eligibility criteria.

6.3 The recommendations of the Commission shall be placed before the syndicate of the concerned University for approval, ordinarily at its next schedule meeting.

7.0 **Joining Date**

7.1 The appointment letter shall clearly specify the time period within which the selected candidate must join the post. This period should normally be one month.

7.2 Upon a written request from the selected candidate, the competent authority, may grant an extension of the joining date for a period not exceeding six months

7.3 If the selected candidate fails to join the post on or before the due date, their appointment shall stand cancelled.

7.4 A candidate recommended for posting in a specific University, shall remain there for a minimum period of 05 (five) years.

Distribution of marks for Short listing/ Selection of Candidates for the Post of Assistant Professors in Universities

1. Written examination of concerned subject will be of 160 marks and of 3 hours duration. The marks obtained in written examination shall be 80% weightage of the total marks.
2. The interview will carry a total of 40 marks (20% weightage of total) marks.




