**B) Application Fees:**

**C) Application Process:-**

- a) Aspiring applicants who meet all the eligibility criteria for the above said post may **submit application through Online Mode** on or before **12<sup>th</sup> June 2026 by 05:00 PM IST.**
- b) **The link for online submission of application will be available on AIIMS Rajkot website from 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2026 onwards.**
- c) **Candidates are advised to fill their correct and active-mail ID in the Online application, as all correspondences will be made by the Institute through e-mail. Test/ Interview schedule will be mailed in due course to the candidate in their registered e-mail.**
- d) The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must be fulfilling eligibility criteria as on the closing date of online applications failing which their application will be rejected.
- e) A separate application must be filled for each post i.e. Associate Professor (Reader) in Nursing, Assistant Professor/Lecturer in Nursing and Tutor/Clinical Instructor.

**D) Maximum Age Limit :-**

- a) Maximum age will be calculated as on the last date of the receipt of the application i.e., **12<sup>th</sup> June 2026.**
- b) Upper age limit shall be determined as on last date of submission of online applications.
- c) No age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC candidates applying for unreserved vacancies.
- d) Age relaxation permissible to various categories is as under: -

- e) Age relaxation to other categories of the candidates will also be applicable as per the DoPT instructions. However, age relaxation will be regulated as per the DoPT instructions.
- f) Unless otherwise indicated in the recruitment rules, age relaxation of 5 years for personnel serving in Central/State Government and Autonomous Institutions of Central & State Govts, and for regular employees of AIIMS concerned who have completed three years of regular service period will be allowed.

## **E) Reservation Criteria: -**

### **(a) For PwBD Candidates:**

Reservation to candidates belonging to Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) category is applicable by Govt. of India Policy, which will be provided on Horizontal basis to PwBD candidates in their respective categories. PwBD candidates with disabilities mentioned in Section 34(1) of the *Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016*, and as identified by the Institute for the above posts, are eligible under the categories OL, AAV, Dw, and LC (OL), provided they have a benchmark disability of 40% or more.

### **(b) Criteria for Person with Benchmark Disability Candidate:**

The disability certificate should be issued by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals / Institutions and countersigned by Medical Superintendent/CMO/ Head of Hospital / Institution. Reservation for PwBD will be as per the guidelines/Instruction contained in DoP&T OM No. 36035/02/2017-Estt (Res) dated 15.01.2018 with regard to reservation for persons with disabilities. Only such persons would be eligible for reservation under PwBD quota in service/posts who suffer from not less than 40% of physical disability. Person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation would have to submit a Disability Certificate as issued by a Competent Authority in prescribed format. However, the candidature of PwBD applicant is subject to evaluation by a Medical Board duly constituted by the Executive Director of respective AIIMS or by the respective institute. This Medical Board will evaluate suitability of candidates for the post he/she is being considered for. All the instructions of Govt. of India as amended and as applicable in this matter will be followed.

### **(c) For OBC Candidate:-**

Candidates applying under OBC category must produce the valid caste certificate in the format provided by the DoP&T vide O.M. No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res.) dated 30.05.2014 and further clarification issued by DoP&T OM No. 36036/2/2013 Estt(Res-I) dated 31.03.2016. The certificate must mention the non-creamy layer status of the applicant (Non-creamy layer status issued by an authority mentioned in DOPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93- Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993). The OBC applicants who belong to the "Non-Creamy Layer" and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs (notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes available at the website <http://ncbc.nic.in>, shall be eligible to be considered under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC Certificate in respect of non-creamy layer status of the applicants as per DOPT Office Memorandum No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res-I) dated 31 March 2016). The validity of the non-creamy layer certificate shall be issued for the financial year 2026-27 (which is the year of advertisement) (considering income up to financial year ending on 31<sup>st</sup> Mar, 2026), issued on or after **1<sup>st</sup> April 2026**. If the applicant does not have the OBC non-creamy layer certificate valid for the financial year 2026-27 at the time of applying, the applicant must submit the previously issued (older) OBC non-creamy layer certificate or the acknowledgment slip of the OBC non-creamy layer certificate application. However, at the time when asked to submit/upload the valid certificate, the applicant must produce the applicable certificate valid for financial year (2026-27) as said above. This additional certificate (if any) must have a reference of his / her already issued original caste certificate. Applicants are advised to upload receipt/application for OBC non-creamy layer certificate if, OBC non-creamy layer certificate is not available.

**(d) For EWS Candidate: -**

The vacancies advertised under EWS Category are as per the instructions issued by DoPT, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension, Govt. of India, vide OM. No. 36039/1/2019- Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019. Application under EWS category will be considered subject to submission of Income and Assets certificate on a prescribed format issued by the competent authority and subject to verification of genuineness of the certificate by the issuing authority. In pursuance to DoP&T OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019, a EWS certificate issued in prescribed format for employment in Central Government on the basis on income of financial year 2026-2027, issued on or after **1<sup>st</sup> April 2026**. If the applicant does not have the EWS Category certificate valid for the financial year 2026-27 at the time of applying, the applicant must upload the previously issued (older) EWS certificate or the acknowledgment slip of the EWS certificate application. However, at the time when asked to submit/upload the valid certificate, the applicant must produce the applicable certificate valid for financial year (2026- 27) as said above.

**(e) For SC/ST Candidate: -**

The vacancies advertised under SC/ST category are as per the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time. Candidates applying under SC/ST category must submit a valid Caste Certificate in the prescribed format issued by the competent authority empowered to issue such certificates under the Government of India rules. The certificate should clearly indicate that the candidate belongs to a Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST) recognized by the Government of India. The candidature under SC/ST category shall be considered subject to verification of the genuineness of the certificate by the issuing authority. Candidates belonging to SC/ST category are advised to ensure that their caste certificate is in the prescribed format applicable for appointment to posts under the Central Government.

**(f)** Candidates who fail to produce valid category certificate OBC/EWS/SC/ST/PwBD etc. during document verification before interview or as and when required to produce the same, the candidature will be cancelled. All candidates are advised to obtain required valid category certificate in advance to avoid cancellation of candidature at any stage of the recruitment process.

**(g)** Candidates who have claimed the reservation category and failed to produce a valid category certificate as applicable as per published criteria the candidature shall be cancelled in the reserved category, and allocated seats shall be forfeited.

**(h)** Candidates applying under any of the reserved category posts, viz. SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD will be considered subject to Caste/PwBD Certificate issued by the appropriate/Competent Authority in the prescribed format. Community should be clearly and legibly mentioned in the Certificate.

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The post carry usual allowances as admissible to Central Government Employees of similar status stationed at AIIMS Rajkot, Gujarat.
2. The candidates are to satisfy all eligibility criteria before online application. They must possess the educational qualification and experiences as recognized by the Govt. of India. Their candidature will be cancelled at any stage if it is found that their educational qualification or experiences are not recognized by the Govt. of India.
3. **Experience:** - The experience will be counted as on last date of submission of online application after obtaining the prescribed educational qualification.
4. **All applicants must appear in the Computer-Based Screening Test (CBT). There will be one CBT for the post of Tutor/Clinical Instructor and one common CBT for the posts of Associate Professor (Reader) in Nursing and Assistant Professor/Lecturer in Nursing. The CBT is only for the purpose of shortlisting candidates for the interview, and the marks obtained in the CBT will not be counted towards the Final Merit List. The minimum qualifying percentile for each category in each of the above-mentioned tests, for being eligible to be considered for the interview, is given in Para 13. Candidates who qualify in the CBT will be called for the interview in the ratio of 1:10 (10 candidates for each vacancy/category). Merely qualifying in the CBT does not entitle a candidate to be called for the interview. The final selection will be based solely on interview marks.**
5. **Site of Interview:** Interviews will be held at AIIMS Rajkot or any other place as decided by the Executive Director, AIIMS, Rajkot. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the Exam/ Interview.
6. **Document Verification:** The original certificates/documents of successful candidates will be verified for which dates will be notified after declaration of screening test result or before the interview. On the basis of screening test, if any, the provisionally qualified candidates will be required to produce following original certificates/ documents along with one set of photocopies, duly self-attested viz.:
  - i) Copy of Admit Card (if Written Examination held).
  - ii) Certificate showing Date of Birth. (10th Certificate/ Birth Certificate).
  - iii) Class 10th & 12th Marksheets and Certificates.
  - iv) All Originals documents in support of Essential Qualification for the above mentioned post.
  - v) Caste certificate if applied under SC/ST/OBC/EWS category issued by the competent authority.
  - vi) The Disability Certificate, if applied under Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) category.
  - vii) No Objection Certificate if in regular employment in Government/Semi Government/PSU Institution.
  - viii) Experience Certificate, if any (With Supporting evidence viz. PF/ESI/Account Statement/Salary slip along with experience certificate).
  - ix) Identity Proof (PAN Card, Passport, Driving License, Voter Card, Aadhaar Card and Government Approved Identity Proof)
  - x) Address Proof (Aadhaar Card, Passport, Ration Card, Driving License and Government Approved Address Proof)
  - xi) Any other relevant documents.

7. **No Objection Certificate** from the present employer (In case of candidates working in Government/Semi or Quasi Government/PSUs/Autonomous Bodies or any institution funded by Government) is mandatory, otherwise, candidature will not be considered for any post. Therefore, candidates are requested to obtain the same before applying. Further, it is mandatory to produce the same NOC at the time of Document Verification. Candidates, who are working as contractual employee in Government/Semi Government/PSUs/ Autonomous Bodies or any institution funded by Government, also have to produce NOC mandatorily.
8. **AIIMS, Rajkot decision will be final:** The decision of the AIIMS, Rajkot in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination(s), allotment of examination centers if any, selection and allotment of posts to selected candidates will be final and binding on the candidates and no enquiry / correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
9. SC/ST/OBC candidates who opt to apply for unreserved vacancies will not be eligible for age relaxation or relaxation in cut-off marks otherwise allowed to those belonging to these categories. Further, reserve category candidates (SC/ST/OBC) who become eligible by age relaxation applicable in their case will be considered only for reserved seats of the category to which they belong even if they have the merit to be considered otherwise for UR.

- The syllabus for the CBT screening test will be according to the M.Sc. Nursing curriculum as prescribed by Indian Nursing Council.

**11. Selection Procedure:**

**IMPORTANT: TO AVOID ANY HASSLE TO REACH THE EXAMINATION CENTRE ON TIME, THE CANDIDATES ARE ADVISED TO VISIT THEIR RESPECTIVE EXAMINATION CENTRE ONE DAY PRIOR TO THE EXAMINATION OR AS PER THEIR CONVENIENCE.**

## 12. Type of Paper:

Candidates will be shortlisted for interview based on a screening test consisting of 60 multiple choice questions (MCQs) with four options each. There will be Negative marking to the tune of **0.25 marks for each wrong answer.**

**The medium of examination will be English only.**

## 13. Criteria for Selection

- (a) The shortlisting for in terview will be made strictly in order of merit of the candidate in the respective merit lists of screening test.
- (b) And overall merit list based on percentile, obtained by all the candidates appearing in the screening test (irrespective or their category) will be prepared. The candidates of various categories who overall percentile in the test as mentioned against each category, will be eligible to be considered for the interview.

- (c) In the matter of selection, the decision of the Executive Director, AIIMS Rajkot shall be final.
- (d) B.Sc. (Nursing) / M.Sc. (Nursing) must be from an institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
- (e) The registration of the Degree Certificate must be valid with the respective State Nursing Council.
- (f) Shortlisting of candidates for document verification and personal interview does not confer any rights for selection. The candidature of all the shortlisted candidates for certificate verification and personal interview is purely provisional subject to verification and fulfilment of eligibility criteria concerning age, essential qualification, experience, etc, and if found ineligible at any stage, their candidature will be cancelled.
- (g) The performance in CBT will carry NO WEIGHTAGE in the interview and the final selection will be based on the performance in the interview only.

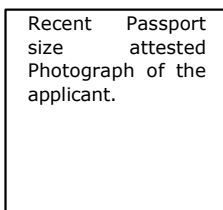
