The All-India Institute of Medical Sciences, Rajkot, Gujarat is a Central Autonomous Body (CAB) formed by an Act of the Parliament. The administrative ministry is *Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Surakasha Yojana* division of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. AIIMS, Rajkot adheres to AIIMS Act, Rules and Regulations available on the website of the PMSSY and also on website www.aiimsrajkot.edu.in. The posts of Faculty (Professor, Additional Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor in various disciplines, are governed by Act, Rules and Regulations of AIIMS, Rajkot. The candidates are expected to apprise themselves of provisions of AIIMS Act, Rules and Regulations before deciding to apply for this position.

All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Rajkot, Gujarat invites applications from the citizen of India Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) for filling up the vacancies in the post indicated in the table below. UR candidates are permitted to apply against posts earmarked for EWS subject to the following conditions:

- That their candidature will be considered only if EWS applicants are not available.
- That their candidature will be as UR candidates only, which means all candidates are permitted to apply, but there shall be no relaxations which are otherwise permitted under their specific categories.

(This decision has been taken considering the factual data of previous recruitment wherein no applications were received for posts earmarked for EWS; and that it is important to establish Hospital and patient care facilities in AIIMS Rajkot in public interest.)

1. The above vacancies are provisional and subject to variation. The Executive Director, AIIMS, Rajkot reserves the right to vary the vacancies including reserved vacancies as per the Govt. of India rules/circulars and requirements.
2. Reservation will be as per Government of India guidelines issued from time to time.
3. Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) will be as per Government of India guidelines in accordance with Notification No. 38-16/2020-DD-III dated 04.01.2021 issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India or as identified by the Institute considering the functional/physical requirements of the post.
4. Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) shall be applicable as per Govt. of India, Office Memorandum No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) DoPT dated 19th January, 2019 and 31st January, 2019: EWSs Candidates will attach certificate issued by the competent authority in the form prescribed as per Annexure – IV EWS.

As per EWS guidelines posts are not carried forward/or considered as backlog vacancy in case unfilled; hence other category candidates will be allowed provisionally to apply for post subjected to condition that they will be considered for the post as an UR Candidate only, if EWS category seat is otherwise not filled.
6. Reservation to SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD will be given as per instructions issued by Department of Training, Government of India from time to time read with the advertisement.
7. Age and all other qualification will be counted as on the last date of submission of application (crucial date).
8. Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholders under section 7(A) of Citizenship Act, 1955 are also eligible to apply for teaching post as per Ministry of Home Affairs Order No. 26011/52/2016- OCI dated 02nd August, 2018.
9. The period of experience wherever prescribed shall be counted after obtaining the prescribed qualification, on the last date of application (crucial date).

1. Educational Qualification for Non-Medical Candidates (as applicable)

2. The candidate must be registered with the State Medical Council/ NMC.

3. DNB Equivalence: In case of those who are holding DNB in broad specialties or super specialties as qualifying education, they have to produce documentary evidence issued by competent/appropriate authority about DNB equivalence with MD/MS/DM/MCh as per MCI, New Delhi notification dated 31- 10-2018. Those who have undergone DNB training from Institutions given under para 2 at (a) and (b) of aforementioned MCI notification-will not need to have extra experience after qualifying degree. Those who have undergone DNB training at Institution given at (c) and (d) of aforementioned MCI notification will need to have 1 year and 2 years extra experience i.e. total 4 & 5 years' experience respectively from MCI recognized/ permitted Institution for equivalence.

4. The relaxation of essential teaching/research experience for one year for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes will be given as per Rules/ Guidelines issued by DoP&T.

- All the posts carry usual allowances as admissible to Central Autonomous Body (like other AIIMS) / Central Government Employees of similar status at Rajkot, Gujarat.

- The Posts of Professor and Additional Professor are to be filled up by direct recruitment failing which deputation basis.** The application for deputation only should be routed through their employer and the same shall be sent along with attested copies of ACRs/APARs for last five years and Vigilance Clearance Certificate through Speed Post.
- Application Process:**

 - The candidate must ensure that their photo, signature and thumb impression should be clearly visible in preview at the time of online application. If photo/signature/thumb impression image is displayed small or not visible in preview on website, that means photo/signature is not as per the AIIMS, Rajkot prescribed guidelines and in that case, their application can be rejected. So, candidates are advised to be very careful while uploading their photo and signatures. Both must be visible clearly on Online Application Form before final submission.
 - The candidate must email the signed scanned copy of Brief of candidate in format given in **Annexure – II** to email facultyrecruitmentaiimsrajkot@gmail.com.
 - No documents including online application form is required to be sent physically, however, all the applicants are advised to keep a hard copy of online application forms with them along with proof of payment (a copy of online payment receipt) for their records.
- The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the post applied for. They must be fulfilling eligibility criteria as on the closing (crucial) date of applications failing which their application will be rejected.

Associate Professor/ Assistant Professor: Not exceeding 50 (Fifty) years as on closing date of application (Crucial Date).

i. Upper age limit shall be determined as per 'crucial date.'

ii. No age relaxation would be available to SC/ST/OBC/PwBD/EWS Candidates applying for unreserved (UR) vacancies.

a) Age relaxation to other categories of the candidates will also be applicable as per the DoPT instructions. However, age relaxation will be regulated as per the DoPT instructions.

b) Unless otherwise indicated in the recruitment rules, age relaxation of 5 years for personnel serving in Central/State Government and Autonomous Institutions of Central & State Govts, and for regular employees of AIIMS concerned who have completed three years of regular service period will be allowed.

10. Candidates applying under SC/ST category will be considered subject to production of Caste Certificate issued by the appropriate/ Competent Authority. Community should be clearly and legibly mentioned in the certificate.

11. Candidates applying under OBC category must produce the valid caste certificate in the format provided **Annexure - III** by the DoP&T vide O.M No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res.) dated 30.05.2014 and further clarification issued by DoP&T OM No. 36036/2/2013-Estt (Res-I) dated 31.03.2016. The certificate must mention the non-creamy layer status of the applicant (Non-creamy layer status issued by an authority mentioned in DOPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993).
