A nominal leader with no real power

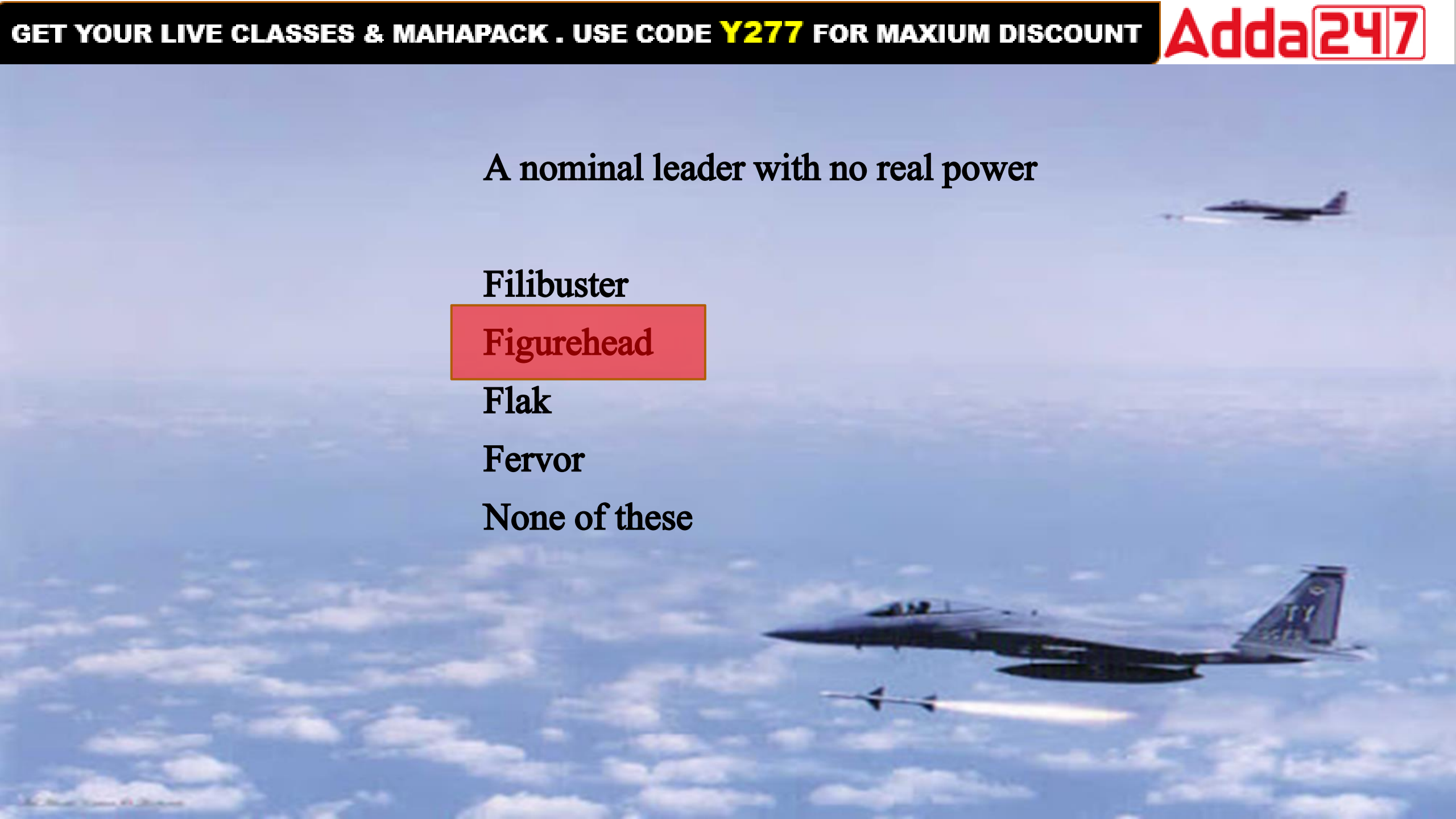
