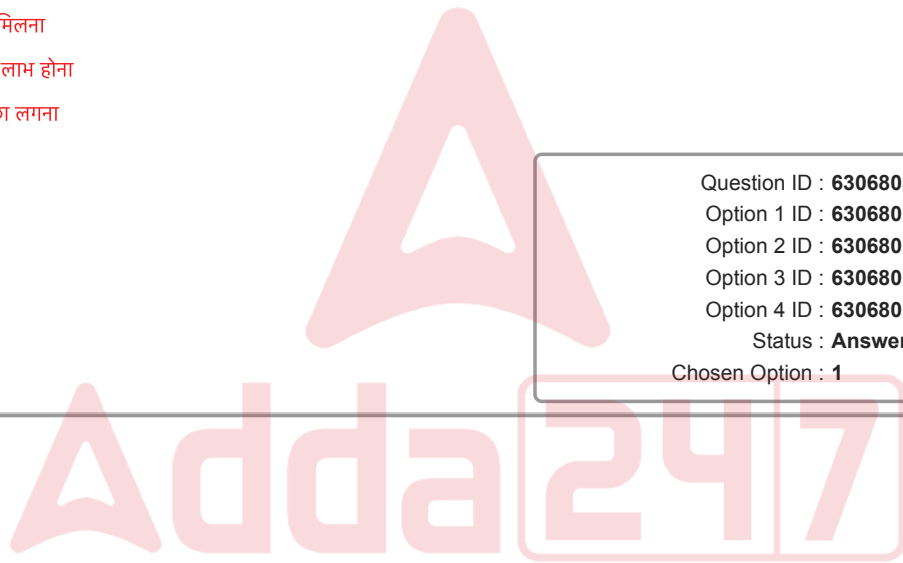

समाचार लेखन की उल्टा पिरामिड शैली के तहत लिखे गये समाचारों को सुविधा की दृष्टि से मुख्यतः तीन हिस्सों में विभाजित किया जाता है- मुखड़ा या इंट्रो या लीड, बॉडी और निष्कर्ष या समापन। इसमें मुखड़ा या इंट्रो समाचार के पहले और कभी-कभी पहले और दूसरे दोनों अनुच्छेदों को कहा जाता है। मुखड़ा किसी भी समाचार का सबसे महत्वपूर्ण हिस्सा होता है, क्योंकि इसमें सबसे महत्वपूर्ण तथ्यों और सूचनाओं को लिखा जाता है। इसके बाद समाचार की बॉडी आती है, जिसमें महत्व के अनुसार घटते हुए क्रम में सूचनाओं का ब्यौरा देने के अलावा उसकी पृष्ठभूमि का भी जिक्र किया जाता है। सबसे अंत में निष्कर्ष या समापन आता है।

समाचार लेखन में निष्कर्ष जैसी कोई चीज नहीं होती है और न ही समाचार के अंत में यह बताया जाता है कि यहां समाचार का समापन हो गया है।
