In 1948 a special United Nations mission, headed by Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, the wife of US President Franklin D. Roosevelt, wrote a special document which stated the rights that all people should have. This document is called the "Universal Declaration of Human Rights." "Universal" means "of all the world." This is because when people don't know their natural rights things such as injustice, discrimination, intolerance and slavery can happen.
