Read the given passage carefully and answer the questions that follow.

Made from the seed of the cocoa tree, chocolate is one of the best sources of antioxidants on the planet. Studies have proved that dark chocolate can help to lower the risk of heart disease, increase blood flow, lower blood pressure and also improve the functioning of the brain.

Did you know that the history of chocolate goes back at least 4,000 years! In fact, the origin of the word "chocolate" can be traced to the Aztec word 'xocoatl', which referred to a bitter drink brewed from cacao beans. The Latin name for the cacao tree is Theobroma cacao, and means 'food of the Gods'. Olmec, Mayan and Aztec civilisations of Central and South America found chocolate to be an invigorating drink and mood enhancer, which led them to believe that it possessed magical and divine properties. The Mayans worshipped the God of cacao and reserved chocolate for rulers, warriors, priests and nobles at sacred ceremonies. The Aztecs thought that their bitter cacao drink was a divine gift from heaven.

It is believed that Christopher Columbus was the first European to discover the existence of cacao tree in around 1502 and seized some cacao plants from the natives to bring back to Spain. However, the natural taste of cacao was too bitter for most people. To sweeten the drink, Europeans added honey or cane sugar to the cacao drink. As a sweet drink, it became more popular with the people.

Chocolate is made from cocoa beans which grow on a cacao tree. The fruits of these trees are called pods and inside the pods one can find the seeds or the cocoa beans surrounded by a soft, white pulp. As the beans are very hard and bitter to taste, they are processed before they can be consumed. In the first step, the beans are removed from the pods and left for a few days in a bucket covered with banana leaves. This process is called fermenting. After fermentation is drying, wherein, the beans are left to dry in the sun. These two processes help to reduce the bitterness of the bean. Then, the beans are shipped to a factory where they are roasted in order to bring out their flavour. Then, they are heated and melted into chocolate liquor. Lastly, manufacturers blend chocolate liquor with sugar and milk to enhance the flavour.
