And in that very moment of humility, sport truly became a metaphor for life. The unpredictability and unfairness of life escapes no one. There are times we get unsatisfactory results despite our best efforts. It is easy to give into frustration in such situations. Why wouldn't you? You did your best and yet things didn't turn out the way you wanted. And there is nothing you can do to change things.

Actually, winning and losing are social constructs. A winner one day can be a loser next and vice versa. When we think in win-loss terms, we give into the illusion that we can control everything. But that's not how life works. Googlies are as much part of cricket as they are of the universe. In that sense, sport not just familiarises us with victory and defeat, it also teaches us to accept victory and defeat with equanimity. As in life, it is the process that matters, not the end result. A true sportsman is one who realises that the only thing within his power is to be the best version of himself on the field. The New Zealand team's conduct in the World Cup can serve as a benchmark in this regard.

We must all try to be the best versions of ourselves, no matter the end result. Perhaps it will help to realise that the real match is actually with oneself. We all have that little voice within us that says we can do better. Winning and losing are part of life, but what we should aim for is a tie with our inner voice.
