Important Points:

- Sectional timing: 15 min per part (new addition) | +20 min extra for scribe-eligible candidates.
- Negative marking: -0.5 per wrong answer | Bilingual (Hindi & English) | Same pattern for Matric/12th/Graduate levels — only difficulty differs.
- One single post-independent CBT score is used to fill ALL post codes you're eligible for and have opted — there's no separate exam per post.

3 SSC SELECTION POST Selection Process

Stage 1

Computer Based Examination (CBE)
Objective MCQs across Parts A–D; scores normalized if conducted in multiple shifts.

Stage 2

Scrutiny of Documents
Shortlisted candidates (by ratio, see below) upload self-attested documents for Educational Qualification, Age, Category, Experience, etc.

Stage 3

Document Verification (DV)
Conducted by the concerned User Department/ Organization to which the post belongs.

Stage 4

Skill Test
Only where prescribed for the post; qualifying nature.

No interview at any stage.
Final merit is based purely on normalized CBE marks.
