WB Fisheries dept eyes production increase and job generation	Context WB's Fisheries department is reaching out to the grassroots level through Matsya Karmadakshya (fisheries supervisor) in every district.  Key points  It is to push for an increase in fish production and employment generation in the sector.  The role of Karmadakshya involves allotment of block-wise quota for beneficiaries' selection under different developmental schemes.  Did you know?  West Bengal is the second-largest fish-producing state, contributing approximately 14% to India's total production and Uttar Pradesh follows closely as the third-largest with a 7% contribution.

Matsyajeebi Bandhu Scheme	<ul> <li>Key features:         <ul> <li>WB govt launched the Matsyajeebi Bandhu Scheme in 2023.</li> <li>Matsyajeebi Bandhu Scheme is also known as Matsyajeebi Bandhu (Death Benefit ) scheme.</li> <li>WB Govt provides one-time financial assistance of Rs. 2 lakh for the deceased fishermen's family.</li> <li>The Nodal Department of this Scheme is the Department of Fisheries, Aquaculture, Aquatic Resources and Fishing Harbours, Government of West Bengal.</li> <li>Under this scheme only those fishermen eligible registered themselves in the fishermen registration portal of the Department of Fisheries, aquaculture, Aquatic Resources, and Fishing Harbours, the government of West Bengal.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Study on Sunderbans	Context Sunderbans region has recorded the world's highest drowning mortality rate of 243 per lakh population among children in the age group of one to four in three years before the COVID-19 pandemic, according to a study.  Key facts  The region has a mortality rate of 38.8 per lakh population among children aged between five and nine.  The survey was carried out by the non-governmental organization Child in Need Institute (CINI), in partnership with global agencies Royal National Lifeboat Institution (RNLI) and The George Institute (TGI)  The aim was to gauge the enormity of the problem of drowning among children in the coastal Sunderbans region.

### 19-point charter of demands for the protection of wildlife

#### Context

Around 12 wildlife and nature conservation organizations of North Bengal collaboratively submitted a memorandum with 19 demands related to wildlife conservation and protection, in Siliguri

## **Key demands**

- They mainly highlighted a few points related to wildlife, especially elephants, and demanded unscientific elephant driving to be stopped.
- They also expressed concern about the mortar shells and Army weapons that have been floating on the Teesta River due to the flood, as these can affect the wildlife.
- They also demanded illegal river mining be stopped as it diverts the route of rivers.


### Sundarban Biosphere Reserve

## **Key points:**

- The Sundarbans is located on the **delta of the Ganga**, **Brahmaputra**, and Meghna rivers in the Bay of Bengal.
- This Biosphere Reserve includes **Sundarban Tiger Reserve**, Sundarban National Park (core area), Halliday Island, and Lothian Island Wildlife Sanctuaries with Sajnakhali Wildlife Sanctuary forming its buffer area.
- It is designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- The vegetation of the area is moist tropical forests and tidal forests.
- It is home to the Royal Bengal Tiger, Estuarine Crocodile, Gangetic Dolphin, Water Monitor Lizard, etc.
