




The early signs of Alzheimer's disease may be subtle and difficult to notice. They may include:

- 1. Forgetting recent events or conversations
- 2. Repeating questions or stories
- 3. Difficulty finding words
- 4. Difficulty with problem-solving or planning
- 5. Changes in mood or behavior

- Three more tiger cubs were found dead in the Nilgiris, bringing the death toll of tigers recorded in the district to nine animals in just over a month.
