# 1) ANS c) 18th September to 24th September

In 2023, International Week of the Deaf will be observed from 18 to 24 September. World Deaf Day or International Day of the Deaf is celebrated on the last Sunday of September. (September 24, 2023) International Week of the Deaf (IWDP) was first initiated by the World Federation of the Deaf (WFD) in 1958 in Rome, Italy.

## 2) ANS d) 2020

National Medical Commission was constituted in 2020. A 10-year accreditation from the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) is a significant achievement for the National Medical Commission (NMC) of India and the medical education sector in India. With this recognition, 706 medical colleges across the country which are functioning under the National Medical Commission (NMC) will also come under the accreditation of the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME). Similarly, the new medical colleges that will be established in the next 10 years will automatically come under the accreditation of the World Federation. This accreditation will enhance the quality of medical education provided in India and will enable students completing their undergraduate medical studies in India to pursue postgraduate studies and medical training in countries like USA, Canada, Australia and New Zealand.

## 3) ANS a) Ministry of Information and Broadcasting

Shri Apurva Chandra, Secretary, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting today unveiled "People's G20", an eBook on India's G20 Presidency in New Delhi. The book presents a complete journey of India's G20 Presidency. The book consists of three parts, the first part dealing with the monumental G20 Summit that was held between September 9-10, 2023 in New Delhi. The book encapsulates the structure and working of G20 and elaborates on the initiatives that have been taken under India's Presidency of the grouping. The second part provides a summary of the meetings of various Working Groups under the Sherpa and













Finance Track along with the meetings of the Engagement Groups that have been held across the country over the last year since India took over as the Chair.The last part of the eBook presents a photo essay of the Jan-Bhagidari events that were held across the country in the past year transforming India's G20 Presidency into a people-powered movement.

## 4) ANS c) New York

Climate Ambition Summit (CAS) at the United Nations General Assembly on September 21 highlighted the absence of major economies crucial in shaping global emissions reduction efforts. China, the United States, and India, collectively responsible for 42% of global greenhouse gas emissions, were notably missing from this critical event. The CAS aimed to showcase leaders with credible actions and policies to uphold the Paris Agreement's 1.5°C degree goal and promote climate justice.

## 5) ANS a) Paris

2024 Olympic Games will be held in Paris, France, from July to August, while the 2028 Games will be held in Los Angeles, USA, and the 2032 Games will be held in Brisbane, Australia. India won a record 7 medals (one gold, two silver and three bronze) at the 2021 Tokyo Games.

## 6)ANS a) New Delhi

The 14th edition of the Global Skills Summit has begun in New Delhi. The theme of Summit is building skills, empowering youth, and creating a future. The Summit aims to focus on creating a road map for a high-quality industry-led skilling ecosystem in India.

## 7)ANS a) Swati Nayak

Odia scientist Swati Nayak received the Borlaug Field Award for 2023. Norman Borlaug is the "Father of Green Revolution. "Her innovative approach to engaging farmers in demand-driven rice seed systems, from testing and deployment to access and adoption of climate-resilient and nutritious rice varieties.













## 8)ANS d) Madhya Pradesh

Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh inaugurated a 108 feet tall statue of Adi Shankaracharya of the 8th century at Omkareshwar in Madhya Pradesh.

## 9)ANS d) September 23

The United Nations General Assembly has anounced September 23rd as the International Day of Sign Languages to raise awareness about the crucial role sign language plays in upholding the human rights of individuals who are deaf. The theme for this year is "A World Where Deaf People Everywhere Can Sign Anywhere!". This theme underscores the unifying power of sign languages, emphasizing its importance for deaf communities, governments, and civil society organizations.

# 10) ANS a) 24 February 2019

Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana was introduced on 24th February, 2019. This will provide a financial support of Rs 6,000 per annum to all small and marginal farmers as a minimum income support. Union Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare introduced the AI Chatbot enabling farmers to easily access scheme information and facilitating a more efficient process for addressing grievances.
