To conserve dolphin species lives in both river and ocean ,Government of India was launched in 2021. It is under the Wildlife Institute of India, an autonomous body of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. October 5 has been announced as "National Dolphin Day" by Ministry of Environment. Government of Tamil Nadu launches Rs.8.13 crore 'Dolphin Project.Aims to safeguard dolphins and marine habitats.9 dolphin species inhabit Tamil Nadu, Gulf of Mannar. Project enhances marine health, safeguards habitats, and species.

Dr. Muthulakshmi Reddy Maternity Benefit Scheme is a social welfare scheme launched by the Government of Tamil Nadu in 2006. Under this scheme, the beneficiaries are given Rs.18,000 (Central Government Rs 3,000, State Government Rs 15,000) It was being paid in five installments for the first two deposits but now will be paid in 3 installments.

IIT Madras on Monday became the first IIT to open an international campus with the inauguration of a campus in Zanzibar in Tanzania, an east African country. The institute plans to expand its offerings in the future, including postgraduate and undergraduate degrees in areas like ocean engineering and quantum sciences. They also plan to establish a research park and move to a permanent campus within a year and a half.
