Right to Education (RTE) Act, 2009

Why in news?

- The State Platform for Common School System -Tamil Nadu (SPCSS-TN) has urged the State government to provide education under the Right to Education Act, through government or government-aided schools in Tamil Nadu.
- The forum urged the government to take appropriate measures to ensure equitable access to quality education for all children, by admitting them in government or government-aided institutions.

About RTE:

- Education is recognized as a fundamental right under Article 21A of the Indian Constitution, which mandates free and compulsory education for all children aged 6 to 14 years.
- Right to Education Act 2009: This act legally entitles every child between the ages of 6 to 14 years to free and compulsory education in a neighborhood school till completion of elementary education.
- Private schools are required to admit at least 25% of their class strength from 'weaker sections and disadvantaged groups', free of charge.

Gulf of Mannar Marine Biosphere Reserve

Why in news?

- There's growing concern in the Gulf of Mannar Marine Biosphere Reserve, because the coral reefs are showing early signs of extensive damage, known as mass bleaching.
- The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) issuing a red alert for Gulf of Mannar as "above normal" sea surface temperature (SST) is likely to trigger mass bleaching and coral mortality.

About Gulf of Mannar Marine Biosphere Reserve:

- The Gulf of Mannar Marine Biosphere Reserve is situated along the southeastern coast of India, between Tamil Nadu and the west coast of Sri Lanka.
- It was established in 1989 and declared a biosphere reserve by UNESCO under the Man and the Biosphere (MAB) Programme in 2001.

Issue of waqf property	Why in news?
	 The Madras High Court has declared a 2010 amendment unconstitutional. This amendment had brought waqf properties under the Tamil Nadu Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Act of 1976.
	 Key points: This amendment had empowered the Tamil Nadu Waqf Board Chief Executive Officer (CEO) to order the eviction of encroachers. The 2010 amendment made by the State legislature to be repugnant to the Waqf Act of 1995, a Central legislation. The 2010 amendment had been brought in by exercising the power under List III (Concurrent list) and not List II (State list) of seventh schedule to the Constitution. Therefore, a Presidential assent ought to have been obtained for it, in view of its repugnancy with the Central law.
PM's Surya Ghar scheme	 Why in news? The Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation (Tangedco) has issued directives to complete the inspection with regard to PM's Surya Ghar (rooftop solar) scheme.
	 About PM's Surya Ghar scheme: The PM's Surya Ghar scheme, also known as Muft Bijli Yojana, is a government initiative in India. It was launched by Prime Minister on February 15, 2024. The scheme aims to provide free electricity to households in India. Households are provided with a subsidy to install solar panels on their roofs. The objective of this scheme is to reduce the electricity costs of the house by installing rooftop solar panels and using solar energy.

They cannot be accessed under the Right To Information (RTI) Act. This ruling was made by the Tamil Nadu State Information Commission.
			About Tamil Nadu State Information Commission:
			 The Tamil Nadu State Information Commission: The Tamil Nadu State Information Commission was established under the Right to Information Act, 2005. The Commission consists of one State Chief Information Commissioner (SCIC) and several State Information Commissioners. These commissioners are appointed by the Governor of Tamil Nadu based on recommendations from a committee that includes the Chief Minister, the Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly, and a state cabinet minister nominated by the Chief Minister.
