 Tamil Nadu's Drug Control Department is actively monitoring pharmacies to curb the illegal over-the-counter (OTC) sale of scheduled drugs. These drugs, with potential for abuse and addiction, require a valid prescription. To enforce this, regular surprise checks are conducted by drug inspectors and police. 		
Scheduled Drugs: Scheduled drugs are substances classified by their potential for abuse and addiction. They are categorized into schedules (I, II, III, IV, and V) based on their medical use, potential for abuse, and likelihood of dependence. Schedule I: High potential for abuse, no accepted medical use (e.g., heroin, LSD, marijuana). Schedule II: High potential for abuse, accepted medical use with severe restrictions (e.g., oxycodone, morphine, cocaine). Schedule III: Moderate to low potential for abuse, accepted medical use (e.g., codeine, anabolic steroids). Schedule IV: Low potential for abuse, accepted medical use (e.g., Xanax, Valium). Schedule V: Lowest potential for abuse, accepted medical use (e.g., cough syrups with codeine)		
 Context: A recent health department study in Madurai, has revealed a cyclical pattern in dengue outbreaks. The research, spanning from 2012 to 2023, indicates that the disease tends to take on an epidemic form once every five to six years, affecting both rural and urban areas. Key Findings: Cyclic pattern: Dengue cases surged in 2012, 2017, and 2023.

Reservation:

- Reservation is a system of setting aside a certain number of seats or positions for specific social or economically disadvantaged groups.
- In India, it's primarily aimed at uplifting Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), and Other Backward Classes (OBC).

Key Constitutional Provisions:

- **Article 15(4):** Allows the state to make special provisions for the advancement of socially and educationally backward classes.
- Article **16(4):** Provides for reservation in government jobs for SCs and STs.
- **Article 16(4A):** Permits reservation in promotions for SCs and STs.
- Articles 330 and 332: Mandate reservation of seats for SCs and STs in Parliament and State Legislatures.
- Articles 233T and 243D: Ensure reservation for SCs and STs in municipalities and panchayats.

Vanniyar community:

- It is a significant group residing primarily in the northern part of Tamil Nadu.
- Historically classified as a lower caste, they have been actively working elevate socio-religious status since the 19th century.
- Origin: They are believed to be of Dravidian origin and were formerly known as Palli.
- Geographical Distribution: Predominantly found northern Tamil Nadu districts like Chengalpattu, North Arcot, South Arcot, and Salem.
- Occupation: Most Vanniyars are either marginal farmers or landless laborer
