
#### **RGIA** hosts Royal Air Force jets



**In News:** Hyderabad's RGIA hosts Royal Air Force jets for the second time.

- In a sign of growing collaboration and goodwill between the United Kingdom and India, the Royal Air Force (RAF) made a remarkable return to Rajiv Gandhi International Airport (RGIA) in Hyderabad.
- The RAF aircraft landed in India for refueling, marking the second visit to Hyderabad this year.
- RGIA is the **largest airport in India by area**, covering 5,500 acres (2,200 ha).
- It is the **fourth busiest airport** in India by passenger traffic

## Telangana Textiles and Apparel Policy 2017 – 22

#### Context:

- The Telangana Textiles and Apparel Policy 2017-22 (T-TAP) is a strategic initiative by the Telangana state government to boost the textile and apparel industry within the region.
- Since the launch of the T-TAP policy, the textile and apparel sector in Telangana has witnessed significant growth.



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#### **Objectives**

- The primary goal of T-TAP is to create an enabling environment that encourages investments in downstream processing activities related to textiles and apparel.
- It aims to promote spinning, weaving, knitting, processing, and garment manufacturing, including made-ups, within the state.

#### Scope and Coverage:

- T-TAP covers various aspects of the textile and apparel value chain, from raw materials to finished products.
- It targets both new and existing units in the industry.

#### **Key Incentives:**

- Capital subsidy of 25% for conventional textile units and 35% for technical textile units.
- **Rental subsidy of 25%** for the first 5 years of operations for MSMEs in textile and apparel parks.
- Transport subsidy for 5 years for deemed exports.
- Design, product development, and diversification assistance of 20% of the annual expenditure spent on these activities, limited to Rs 2 lakhs per year.
- Training subsidy of Rs 5000/- per person for new projects employing more than 1000 persons.
- Assistance towards training infrastructure in apparel design and development

## Startup Networking event to be held in Hyderabad



#### Context:

 The Global Startups Club announced a Start-up Networking Meeting event to be held in Madhapur.

#### **Key Points:**

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- Over the past three years, Hyderabad has emerged as a significant startup destination with more than 240 funded startups, supported by 550+ domestic and international investors, resulting in a total funding of \$2.6 Bn between January 2014 and August 2023.
- The blend of advanced amenities and cost-effectiveness has positioned Hyderabad as a prime destination for founders and investors, driven by its superior infrastructure (at times, even better than Bengaluru), affordable real estate and competitive cost of living
- The city is increasingly becoming a popular location for B2B SaaS, manufacturing, fintech and IT sectors, partially due to the presence of T-Hub and availability of affordable yet skilled workforce from top institutions like IIT-Hyderabad
