<p>Varikapudisela Project</p>	<p>In News: CM will lay the foundation stone for Varikapudisela Lift Irrigation Scheme in Palnadu district.</p> <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Varikapudi Lift Irrigation Scheme is a major irrigation project in the Palnadu district of Andhra Pradesh, India. • The project aims to provide irrigation to over 1.2 lakh acres of land in 183 villages across six mandals in the district. • The project was inaugurated in 2015 and is expected to be fully completed by 2024. • It will also generate hydroelectricity. • The project will also help to reduce salinity and improve groundwater recharge in the region. • Designed to lift 1.547 tmc ft of water from Varikapudivagu, the Project involves a pump house near Gangulakunta. • This initiative aims to irrigate vast stretches of land and alleviate the water woes that have plagued the region for decades. <p>Key Features Of The Project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drought Mitigation • Land Transformation • Wildlife Considerations

<p>India-Bangladesh Navies undertake CORPAT</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 4th edition of Bilateral Exercise between Indian Navy and Bangladesh Navy, BONGOSAGAR-23, and the 5th edition of Coordinated Patrol (CORPAT) by the two navies was conducted in the Northern Bay of Bengal. • The ships and aircraft from both navies undertook joint patrolling along the International Maritime Boundary Line (IMBL), and subsequently conducted maritime exercises to enhance interoperability.
