- The city was initially known as Suryapuri
- It was ruled by various dynasties, including the Pallavas, Chalukyas, and Kakatiyas.
- Under the rule of the Kakatiyas, Survapet **flourished** as a commercial and cultural center.
- The annual Suryapet Jatara is a major Hindu festival that attracts thousands of pilgrims from across the state.
