Cyclone Michaung aftermath	 Context: Modi instructed release of ₹493.60 cr to Andhra Pradesh and ₹450 cr to Tamil Nadu for cyclone relief.
	 Key Points: Cyclone Michaung caused heavy rains, flooding 1.30 lakh acres of paddy in Kakinada and Konaseema districts. Tuni, Yeleswaram, and other areas in Godavari districts were severely affected by the storm. In Kakinada, 80,000 acres of paddy await harvesting, with 47,000 metric tonnes drenched due to delayed shifting. Konaseema district faces potential crop damage in 9,000 acres if water isn't cleared within three days. Reservoirs at full capacity led to the release of surplus water, damaging crops in Sarabhavaram, Kakinada.
Udan Yojana (Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagarik) scheme	Context:
Ude Desh ka Aam Naagrik	 Center has introduced the Udan Yojana (Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagarik) scheme to make air travel accessible to the common man The scheme incentivizes airlines to operate flights on unserved and underserved routes, connecting smaller cities and towns with major hubs. Airlines bid for routes based on a fixed Viability Gap Funding (VGF) offered by the central and state governments. The scheme has spurred economic activity in Tier-2 and Tier-3 cities, promoting tourism, trade, and investment.
NCRB reports 468 people took their lives in 2022	Context: As per report:
National Crime Records Bureau Ministry of Home Affairs	 Daily 468 persons took their lives in 2022, with one-third of them being daily-wage earners, agriculture laborers, and farmers or cultivators. It also reveals that the rate of suicide per one lakh population has increased to 12.4 in 2022 compared to 10.2 five years ago. Among the major cities, Delhi, Bengaluru, Chennai, and Mumbai reported the highest number of suicides, accounting for almost one-third of all such deaths.
No. of cybercrime cases increased in AP	 Context: A total of 2,341 cybercrime cases were registered in AP in 2022 against 1,875 cases in 2021 and 1,899 cases in 2020.

	 As many as 108 incidents were reported in which 114 women victims suffered due to cybercrimes. A total of 89 cases were registered for publishing or transmitting sexually explicit material in 2022 and 19 cases were registered in which women were victimized in other women-centric cyber crimes such as blackmailing, defamation, morphing, and fake profiles.
