

<p>Martyr's Day</p> 	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Martyrs' Day, also known as Shaheed Diwas, is a day observed in several countries to honor and remember those who have died for their cause, particularly those who have died for their nation. • This day also marks the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi, the "Father of the Nation." • Gandhi was shot dead in 1948 by Nathuram Godse. • India marks the 76th Martyrs' Day on Tuesday, January 30.
<p>Australia to fund new programme at Telangana government's WE Hub</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Australian government will fund a new 13-week pre-incubation program at WE Hub, an initiative of the Telangana government in India. • This program aims to empower women, marginalized communities, and the LGBTIQ+ community in their entrepreneurial endeavors. • StartX, the new programme funded by the Australian government, follows an exclusive pre-incubation programme 'Upsurge,' which had been organized earlier for 180 women entrepreneurs with the support of the Australian High Commission.


	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This comes in view of the death of two tigers within a week in the Kaghnagar division • This is a routine exercise conducted every four years to evaluate the effectiveness of tiger conservation efforts by the state forest department <p>Amrabad Tiger Reserve</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Amrabad Tiger Reserve which is part of the Nallamala Forest track has rich Biological Diversity. • This Forest tract is home to the largest number of Tigers in Telangana State. • This Tiger Reserve (ATR) is one of the largest tiger reserves in India that extends about 2611.4 Sq Km over Nagarkurnool and Nalgonda districts of Telangana State. • This is the second-largest Tiger Reserve in terms of core area but the sixth-largest tiger reserve in terms of total area among 51 Tiger Reserves in India. • The reserve was notified as a sanctuary in the year 1983 and after the bifurcation of Telugu States in 2014, it was declared as Amrabad Tiger Reserve. • It lies in the three forest divisions of Amrabad, Achampet in Nagarkurnool district, and Nagarjunsagar division in Nalgonda district.
3rd anniv of Kazakh-T relations celebrated	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The honorary consulate of Kazakhstan in Hyderabad celebrated its third anniversary at ITC Kohenu, • It marks three years of strengthened relations between Telangana and Kazakhstan. • Among the achievements highlighted were an MoU between Astana and T Hub, Visa-free visits for Indian citizens to Kazakhstan, and plans for a direct flight from Hyderabad to Kazakhstan to further strengthen the bonds between the two regions.
