<p>Geographical Indication (GI) tag</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Sri Konda Laxman Telangana State Horticultural University (SKLTSHU) has filed applications for the Geographical Indication (GI) tags for the Armoor variety of turmeric and Balanagar custard apple grown in the Jadcherla area in Telangana. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A GI tag is a name or sign used on certain products that correspond to a specific geographical location or origin. The GI tag ensures that only the authorized users or those residing in the geographical territory are allowed to use the popular product name. A registered GI is valid for 10 years. GI registration is overseen by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry.
<p>Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) and Per Capita Income (PCI)</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> According to Telangana Economy, there has been a wide disparity among the districts in Telangana in terms of Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) and Per Capita Income (PCI). Rangareddy is the highest in GDDP and PCI, Mulugu lowest in GDDP. <p>Key Points:</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) is a measure in monetary terms, the sum total volume of all finished goods and services produced during a given period of time, usually a year, within the geographical boundaries of the State, accounted without duplication. • Per capita income (PCI) is a measure of the average income earned by each person in a specific area over a given time period, usually a year. It's calculated by dividing the total income of the area by its population: PCI = Total Income / Population
HYDRAA	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Forum for Good Governance (FGG) has urged to extend the jurisdiction of HYDRAA to the entire state by renaming the agency as Telangana Disaster Response and Assets Protection Agency. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HYDRAA stands for Hyderabad Disaster Response and Assets Monitoring and Protection Agency. • Launched in July, HYDRA took on the responsibility of managing disaster response and safeguarding public assets within the Telangana Core Urban Region (TCUR). • They also address illegal hoardings, traffic obstructions, and inspecting unsafe buildings aiming for comprehensive urban resource protection.
Unemployment Rate, Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) & Worker Population Ratio (WPR)	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recently, the urban unemployment rate for men and women aged 15 to 59 in Telangana dropped by 1.7%. • Changes in the unemployment rate are affected by WPR and the Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR). <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unemployment Rate (UR): UR is defined as the percentage of persons unemployed among the persons in the labor force. • Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR): LFPR is defined as the percentage of persons in the labor force (i.e. working or seeking or available for work) in the population. • Worker Population Ratio (WPR): WPR is defined as the percentage of employed persons in the population.

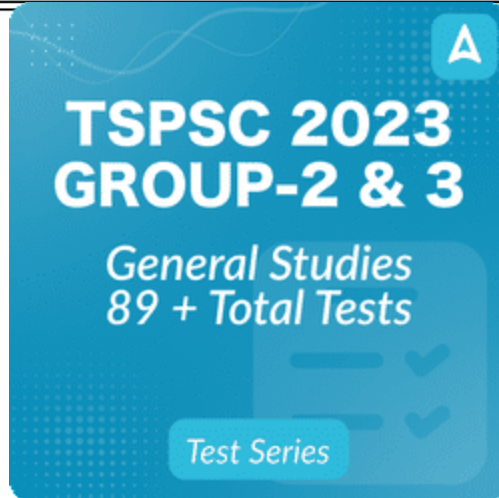
