One Nation-One Election	 Why in news? BRS working president KT Rama Rao has urged the Union government to present a clear plan for One Nation-One Election to the public. Key Points: The One Nation, One Election concept envisions synchronizing Lok Sabha and state elections, allowing citizens to vote for both on the same day. It requires significant constitutional amendments and aims to improve election management and reduce costs.
Per capita income (PCI)	 Why in news? According to a working paper from the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister (EAC-PM) titled "Relative Economic Performance of Indian States: 1960–61 to 2023–24," the relative per capita income in Telangana has reached 193.6% of the national average. Among the large states, Telangana has second highest per capita incomes in the country. Key Points: Per capita income (PCI) is a measure of the average income earned per person in a given area over a set period of time, such as a year. PCI = Total Income / Population It is used to evaluate the standard of living and quality of life of a population. A higher PCI indicates higher purchasing power.
MSME	 Why in news? Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy has launched the Telangana MSME 2024 policy. Key Points: MSME stands for Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises. They are important for the country's industrial development because they support other industries as ancillary units. The policy focuses on addressing six key areas: land acquisition, finance, raw materials, skilled labor, market access, and technology.
