Goods & Services Tax Council (GST Council) is a constitutional body for making recommendations to the Union and State Government on issues related to Goods and Service Tax. The Goods and Services Tax (GST) rate on insurance in India is 18% for term insurance plans and Unit Linked Insurance Plans (ULIPs).

The lamppost is a replica of Sri Narasimha Swamy, according to the inscription. He identified Sanskrit inscriptions dating back to the time of Harihara-Bukkaraya, the founders of

- Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu has announced the proposals for setting up the High Court Bench in Kurnool.

Key Points:

- The High Court is the **apex court in the judicial administration of a State** under the integrated judicial system established by the Constitution of India.
- The **7th Constitutional Amendment Act of 1956** authorized the Parliament to establish a common High Court for two or more States or for two or more States and a Union Territory.
- **Articles 214 to 231 in Part VI** of the Indian Constitution deal with the provisions related to the High Courts.
