<p>Andhra Pradesh: Two branches of NSL textiles selected for DEEP</p>	<p>Why in news?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two branches of NSL Textiles Limited in Inkollu of Bapatla district and Edlapadu of Palnadu district have been selected for implementation of Demonstration of Energy Efficiency Projects (DEEP). It is a joint initiative of BEE (Bureau of Energy Efficiency) and EESL (Energy Efficiency Services Limited), under the Ministry of Power. <p>Key Points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> DEEP is considered to be the largest demonstration/pilot project focussed on the deployment of innovative global technologies to transform energy use in industries. The initiative is designed to support DCs in achieving energy efficiency targets by introducing market-transforming technologies. It aligns with BEE's Perform, Achieve, and Trade (PAT) scheme, enabling industries to meet their Specific Energy Consumption (SEC) targets.
