Once activated, the service tracks the journey in real-time, detecting deviations such as non-responsiveness to alerts, prolonged stoppages, or route changes.</li> <li>If any anomalies are detected, an emergency response ticket is automatically generated and sent to Dial 100, ensuring swift police intervention even if the user is unable to seek help.</li> </ul>

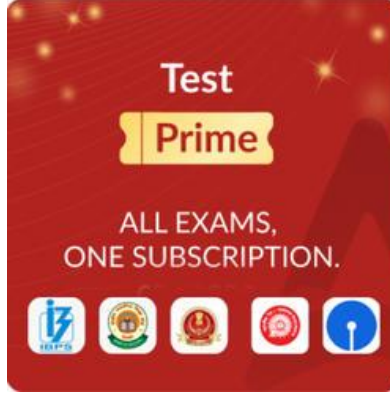
